

How to Get Involved with the Cook-Wissahickon HSA

1. Join the HSA

All parents, guardians, teachers, and staff members are encouraged to become involved with the Cook-Wissahickon Home and School Association by attending our monthly meetings to coordinate plans to support our school community and by volunteering throughout the year. Everyone is welcome to participate in monthly HSA meetings, but only dues-paying members can vote. Membership dues are \$5 per family and additional donations are welcome and greatly appreciated! All money we raise goes toward supporting the school and our students. In the past we've used funds to pay for buses for school field trips, to fulfill teacher requests for supplies, and to fund improvements to the school, such as risers for the choir, the addition of book corners in classrooms, and purchasing whiteboards for classrooms. We have also supported the Wissahickon Sustainability Council's efforts to green the school with the meadow, the outdoor classroom, and more.
